Subject: NDMA Guidelines of School Safety Policy, 2016 – reg.

Madam/Sir,

National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) has prepared guidelines on school safety policy, 2016 to be implemented in all Kendriya Vidyalayas . A copy of the same is available on the official website of NDMA (<http://www.ndma.gov.in/images/guidelines/5school-Safety-Policy.pdf>). These guidelines are formulated to ensure safety of children in schools and all stakeholders involved in the process of ensuring safety of children are statutorily bound by these guidelines. The Hon'ble Supreme Court has directed that the school safety guidelines issued by NDMA have to be implemented in letter and spirit by all concern authorities.

1. These Guidelines on School Safety Policy, 2016 is statutory in nature and are statutorily required to be complied with scrupulously without any deviations in all Kendriya Vidyalayas. Therefore, you are requested to issue necessary directions to Principals of all Kendriya Vidyalaya under your jurisdiction to implement these guidelines. Every school has to implement School Disaster Management Plan Model Template – National School Safety Programme (NSSP) with immediate effect. The NSSP proforma is enclosed in Annexure – 8 of Guidelines of School Safety Policy, 2016. The schools can download the guidelines from above mentioned URL.
2. The supervision team visiting Vidyalayas during Panel and Surprise visits shall also cover the implementation of Guidelines of School Safety Policy, 2016 in Vidyalaya. The team will personally verify and submit a report on National School Safety Programme (NSSP) through Annexure 8 (i), 8 (ii), & 8 (iii) of Guidelines of School Safety Policy 2016, along with specific instruction to Principals to improve the School Safety in accordance with the Policy.
3. Safety and Security of students is a paramount concern for the Kendriya Vidyalayas; hence any lapses and dereliction of duty at any level will be viewed seriously. It is the responsibility of Deputy Commissioners to ensure and monitor the implementation of above said guidelines effectively in all Kendriya Vidyalayas coming in their respective jurisdiction.
