विषय: Celebration of Language Week from 22nd to 27th August, 2016.

महोदय/महोदया,

It has been decided to celebrate Sanskrit Week from 16th to 22nd August and Language Week from 22nd to 27th August, 2016 in all Kendriya Vidyalayas to encourage and motivate children and improve their communicative and linguistic skills in English, Hindi and Sanskrit. The details regarding celebration of Sanskrit Week have already been issued vide letter no. F. 11029/10/2016/KVS(HQ)/Acad. dt.09/08/2016. As far as English & Hindi are concerned, all Dy. Commissioners are requested to issue directions to Principals of Kendriya Vidyalayas under their jurisdiction that the following activities may be organized at Vidyalaya level and students should be encouraged to participate in them:

The norms of participation and assessment of the competitions may be decided at the Vidyalaya level and certificates and prizes be awarded to the students who excel. The details of the celebration held in the Vidyalayas should be uploaded on the Vidyalaya Website immediately.

After the celebration of Sanskrit and Languages Weeks at the Vidyalaya level, the competitions/activities to be held at the Regional and National levels will be restricted to Quiz (in Sanskrit) and Shloka Recitation(in Sanskrit), Kaavya Paath (in Hindi) and Elocution (in English). The Dy. Commissioners of all the KVS Regional Offices are requested to conduct the Regional level competitions for English, Hindi and Sanskrit along with the Regional Social Science Exhibition so that the winners may participate in the National level competition in the National Social Science Exhibition-cum-Integration Camp, together in one go. Accordingly, one escort teacher, preferably a language teacher should accompany the 10 (6+4) students at the Regional/National level in addition to the 4 escort teachers already deputed for the Social Science Exhibition.

*Shloka Recitation/Kavya Path/Elocution – At Regional/ National level, one student of each group (classes VI to VIII & classes IX to XII) will represent the Vidyalaya/Region. The topic/theme of the selected shloka/poem may be patriotism, national integration, social cohesion, youth/women empowerment or folklore. The division of marks will be as follows:



**Quiz – At Regional/ National levels the quiz will be in two rounds. The preliminary round will be a written round, in which 2 students from each Vidyalaya/Region will participate. The top scoring teams will qualify for the final. In the final round, the selected team (of two students) will represent the Vidyalaya/Region. The final quiz will be verbal with audio & visual rounds.

It is hoped that all efforts will be made to ensure active participation of students from all Kendriya Vidyalayas to make the celebration of Sanskrit Week from August 16 to 22, 2016 and Language (English & Hindi) Week from August 22 to 27, 2016 a grand success.
